77" x 89"

## BLOCK SIZE

12½" unfinished, $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished

## QUILT TOP

1 roll $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print strips
3 packages 5" print squares

## INNER BORDER

3/4 yard

## OUTER BORDER

13/4 yard

BINDING


3/4 yard

## BACKING

5½ yards - vertical seam(s) or $23 / 4$ yards of $108^{\prime \prime}$ wide


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## JACOB'S LADDER

The original Jacob's Ladder pattern is needed to complete this quilt.

Use these instructions to modify the original pattern instructions to make the quilt shown by Jenny on January 27, 2023.

## SAMPLE QUILT

Indigo Cheddar by Andover Fabrics

## QUILT SIZE

77" x 89"

## BLOCK SIZE

12½" unfinished, $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished

## QUILT TOP SUPPLIES

4 packages of 5" print squares
$31 / 4$ yards of background fabric

- includes inner border

OUTER BORDER
13/4 yards

## BINDING

3/4 yard

## BACKING

5½ yards - vertical seam(s) or $23 / 4$ yards of $108^{\prime \prime}$ wide

OPTIONAL
Bloc Loc 4 1/2" Square Up Ruler

## sort \& cut

Before following the Section 1 instructions, sort and cut your fabrics.

Sort the $5^{\prime \prime}$ print squares into lights and darks.
$\square 75$ light squares are needed for the 4-patches.
$\square$ Set 60 dark squares aside for the half-square triangles.

From the background fabric:
$\square$ Cut (17) 5" strips across the width of the fabric.
$\square$ Subcut a total of (135) 5" squares from the background fabric.
75 squares are needed for the 4 -patches and 60 squares are needed for the half-square triangles.

## 1 make 4-patches

Replace Section 1 in the original pattern with the instructions below.

Lay a $5^{\prime \prime}$ light print square on top of a $5^{\prime \prime}$ background square, right sides facing.


Sew on 2 opposite sides of the stacked squares, then cut the sewn unit in half vertically and horizontally. Open and press each unit towards the darker fabric. Make 300 units. 1A 1B


Select 2 units and lay them right sides facing with the seams nested. Sew on one side of the stacked units across the previously sewn seams. Open and press. Make (150) 4-patches. 1C 1D

## 2 make half-square triangles

Follow the steps in Section 2 in the original pattern using (60) 5" dark squares and (60) 5" background squares.
Note: The background squares are in place of the light squares in the original pattern.
