
#### **PILLOW SIZE**

10" hexagon

#### **SUPPLIES**

- 1 package of 10" print squares
- 1 yard of backing fabric
- Missouri Star Quilter's Best Blend Crib Batting\*
- · Quilt As You Go Bigs Templates Set
- Fiberfill

\*Missouri Star 5" Diamond, 2½" Jewel, & 2½" Hexagon Precut Batting Shapes may be substituted for the crib batting.




Note: The 2½" triangle and 2½" half hexagon shapes are not used in the throw pillow.

### 1 cut

#### **Inner Shapes:**

☐ Cut a **total of 2** inner hexagons. (1) 10" print square will yield 2 or more of these shapes, but this is a good opportunity to fussy cut if you like. 1A




☐ Cut a **total of 12** inner diamond shapes from the 10" print squares. Nicola cut 2 diamonds from 6 different 10" squares. 1C

#### **Outer Shapes:**

- ☐ From the backing fabric, cut a **total of (5)** 6" strips across the width of the fabric. **1D** 
  - ☐ From 2 strips, subcut a **total of 12** outer jewels. **1D**
  - ☐ From 2 strips, subcut a **total of 12** outer diamonds. **1D**
  - ☐ From 1 strip, subcut a **total of 2** outer hexagons. **1D**

#### Batting (Inner Shapes):

- $\Box$  Cut (4) 4 % '' strips across the width of the batting.
  - ☐ From 1 strip, subcut a **total of 8** inner jewels. **1E**
  - ☐ From 1 strip, subcut **total of 8** inner diamonds. **1E**
  - ☐ From 1 strip, subcut **total of 4** inner jewels and 4 inner diamonds. **1E**
  - ☐ From 1 strip, subcut **total of 2** inner hexagons. **1E**



Make each Quilt As You Go jewel, diamond, and hexagon using the instructions included with the templates. **2A 2B 2C** 

## 3 block construction

Select 6 jewels, 6 diamonds, and 1 hexagon. Join the shapes together as shown to create a full Star in a Hexagon—use a machine zigzag stitch, or put wrong sides together, and slip or ladder stitch by hand. **Make 2. 3A** 

# 4 make the pillow

Lay the 2 blocks wrong sides together. 4A

Whipstitch along the perimeter of the blocks by hand, leaving a 4" opening. Stuff with fiberfill, then whipstitch the opening closed. Your pillow is ready to adorn your favorite space! **4B**
