

16" Round Cuddle® Pillow

PROJECT SIZE

16" diameter

PROJECT SUPPLIES

½ yard of Cuddle® fabric

½ yard of backing fabric

(1) 16" pillow form

1 cut

From the Cuddle® fabric:

- Cut (1) 17" square.
 - Subcut a 17" circle from the square. **Tip:** You can fold the square in half and use the top portion of the template to outline one half of your circle.

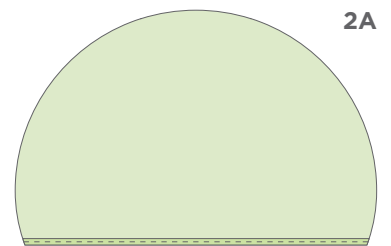
From the backing fabric:

- Cut (1) 12" strip across the width of the fabric.
 - Subcut 2 pillow back panels from the strip using the template.

2 make the pillow back panels

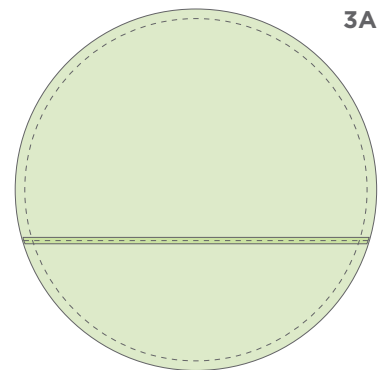
Fold a pillow back panel along the straight edge, ¼" to the wrong side of the fabric. Press. Fold the edge over a second time and press. Topstitch along the folded edge.

Make 2. 2A



3 finish the pillow

Lay the pillow front with the Cuddle® side facing up. Place the two pillow back panels on top of the pillow front, right sides facing down. The topstitched edges will overlap in the middle of the project. Sew around the perimeter of the pillow using a ½" seam allowance. **3A**

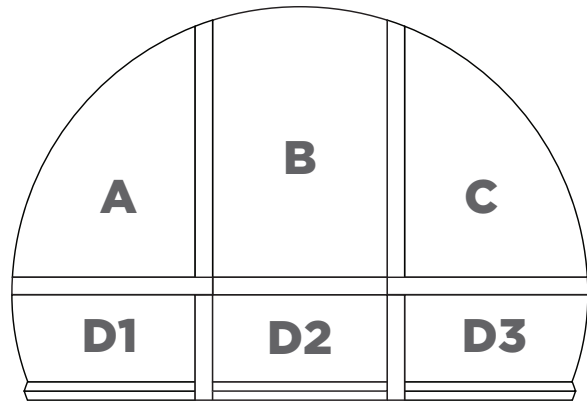


Turn the pillow cover right side out, then insert the pillow form.

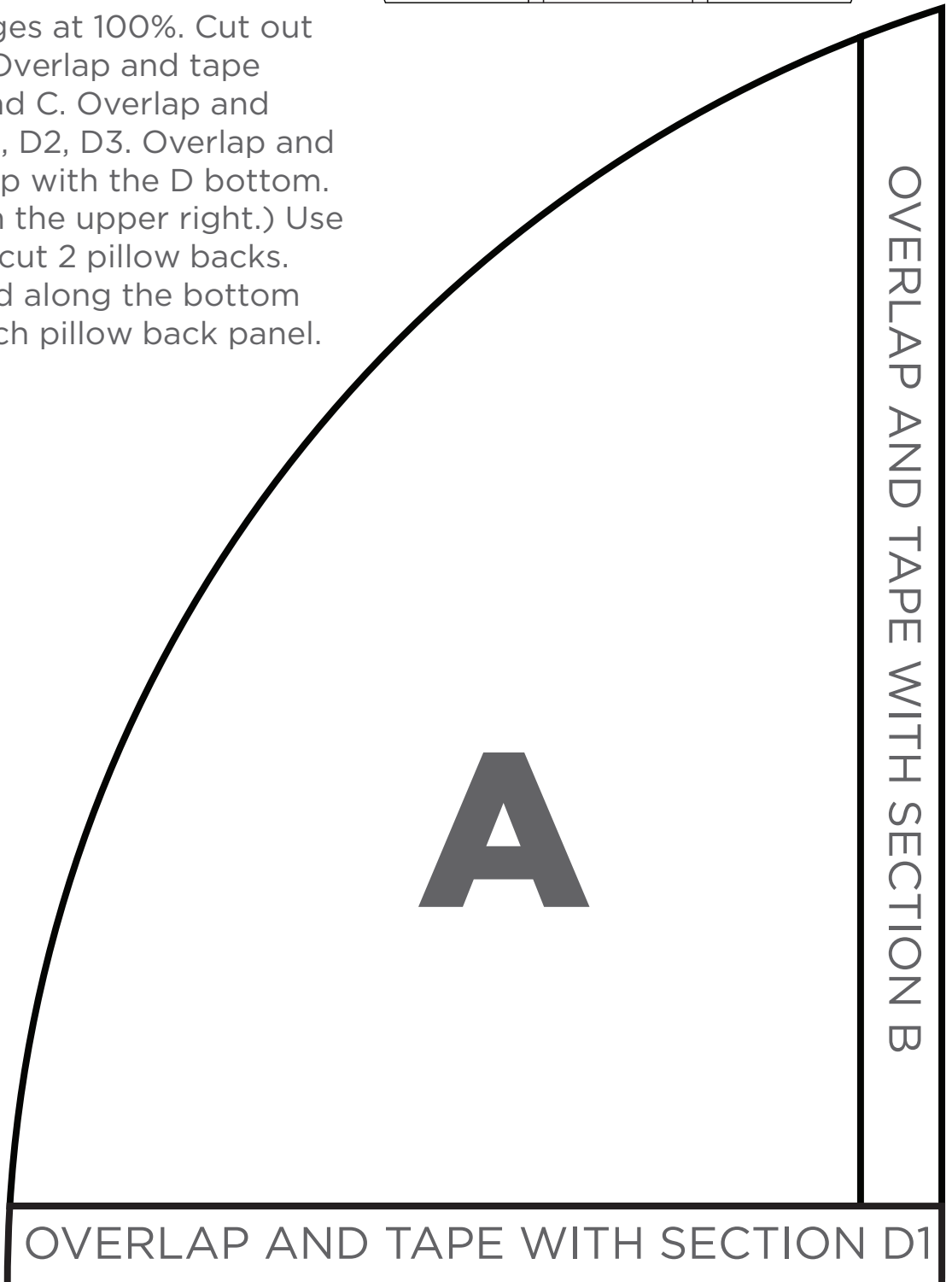

CIRCLE PILLOW TEMPLATE



Print all four pages at 100%. Cut out each template. Overlap and tape sections A, B, and C. Overlap and tape sections D1, D2, D3. Overlap and tape the ABC top with the D bottom. (See diagram on the upper right.) Use the template to cut 2 pillow backs. Fold as indicated along the bottom edge to hem each pillow back panel.

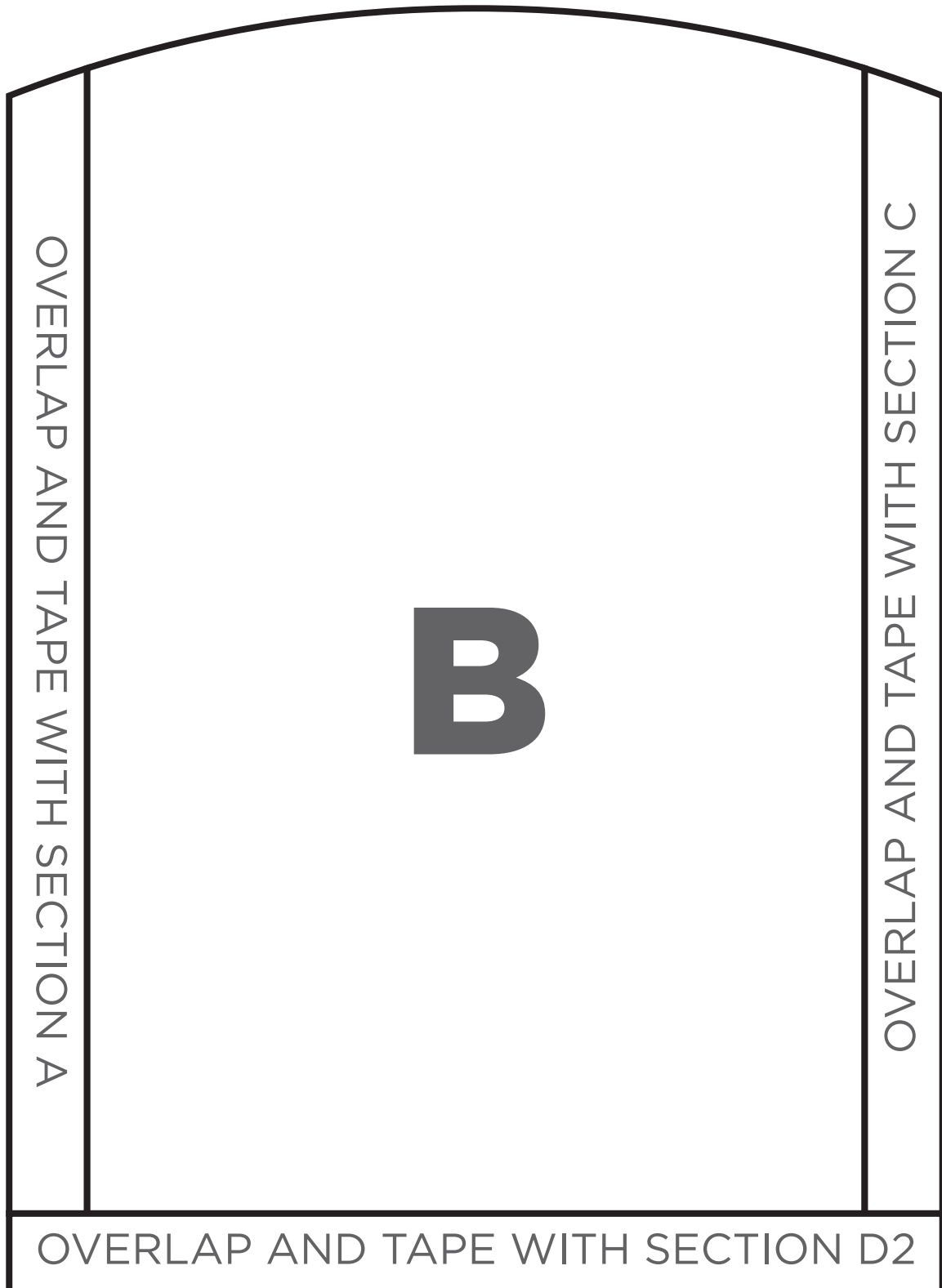

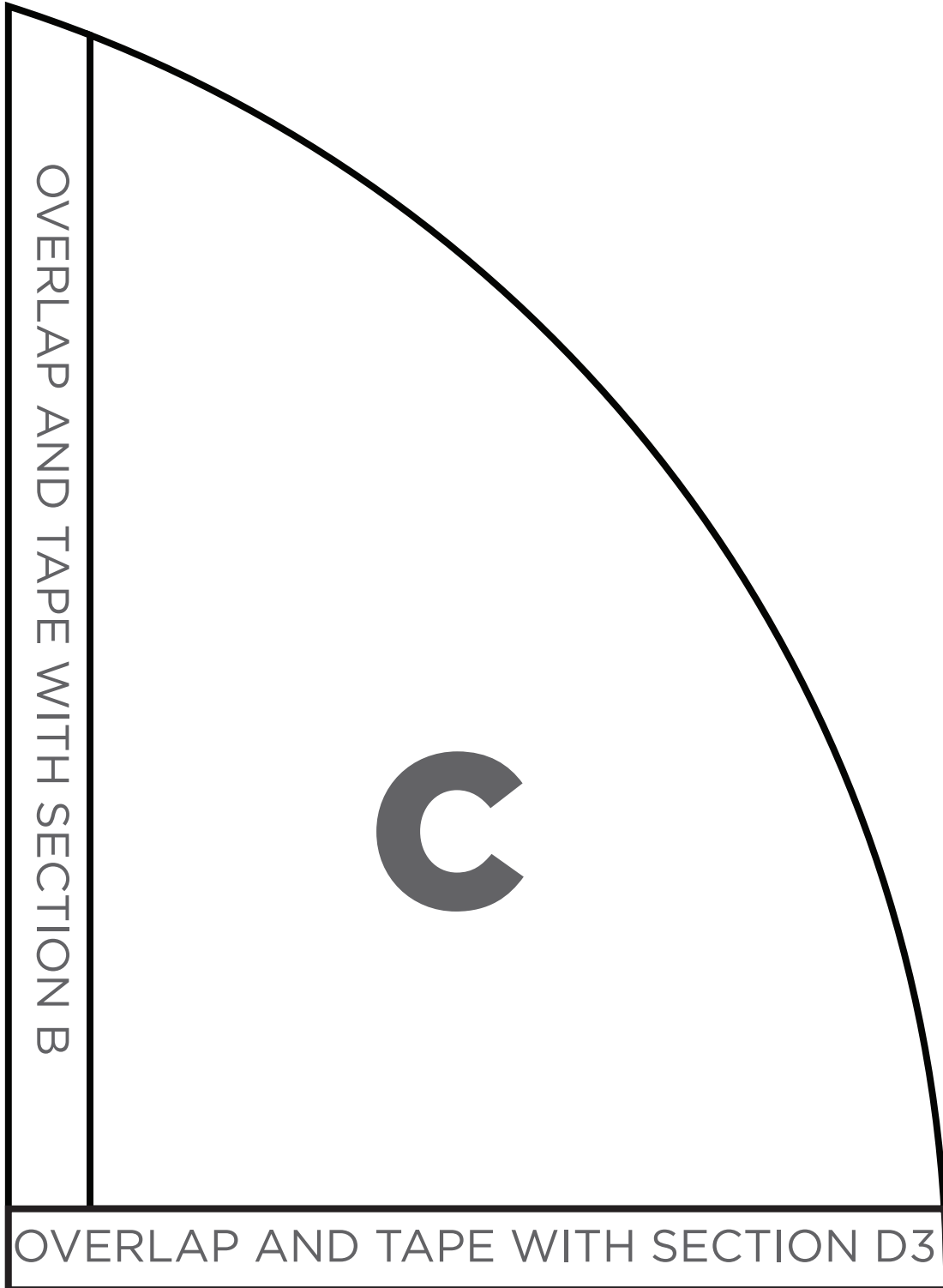
Circle Pillow Template

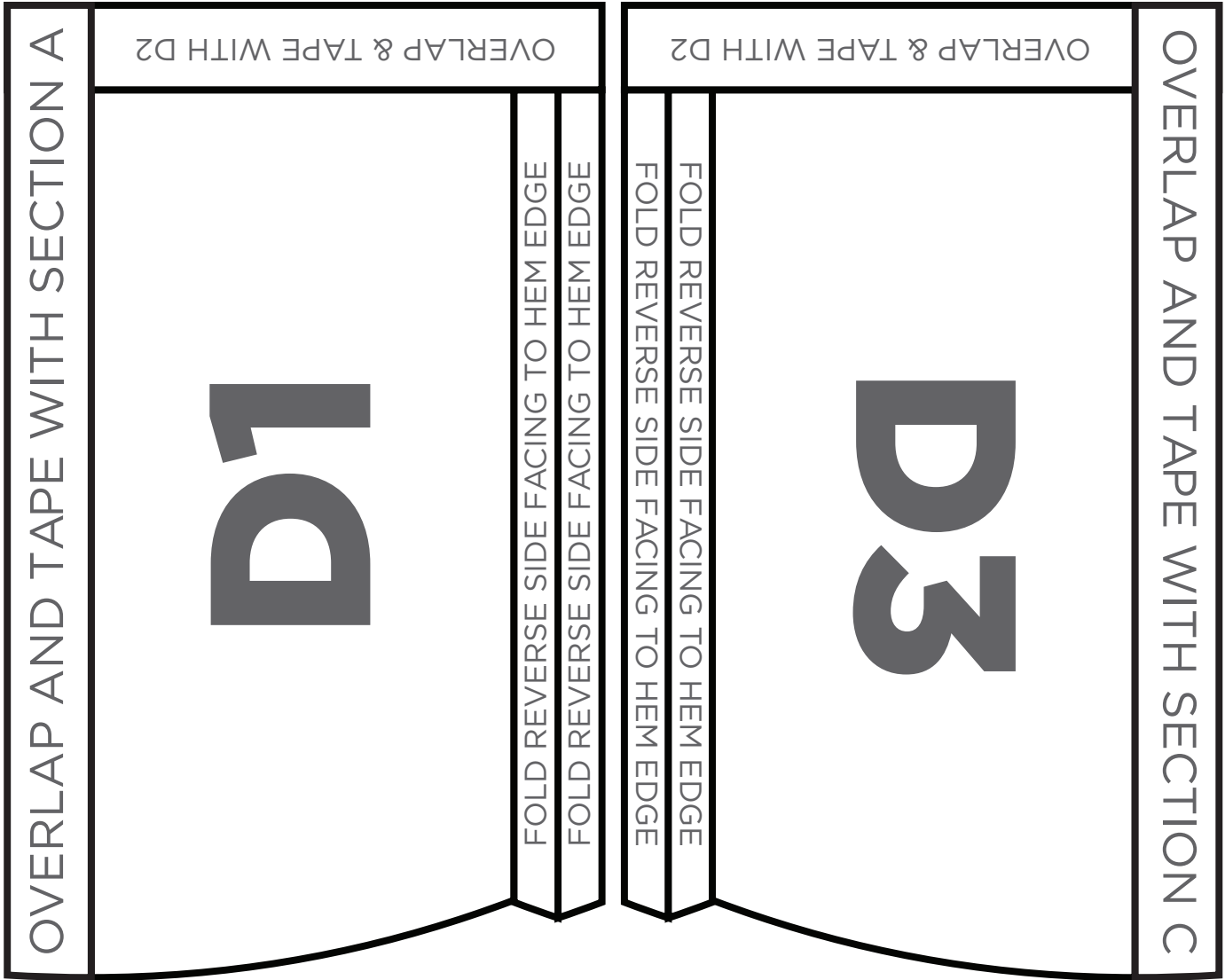
