



At Home with Misty & Craig Sawtooth Star Instructions

Sample Project: Kona Cotton Solids - White and Essex Yarn Dyed Linen - Steel and Black by Robert Kaufman Fabrics

Block Size: 8½" unfinished, 8" finished

Block Supplies:

(1) 10" white square

⅛ yard light accent fabric

⅛ yard dark accent fabric

1 cut

Tip: You may find a rotating or small cutting mat helpful for making this block. Simply make the cuts in 1 direction, rotate the mat, and make the remaining cuts. This reduces the chance of accidentally shifting the pieces between cuts and improves accuracy.

Trim the 10" white square to 9½". Then, measure and cut 2½" from each side of the 9½" square, turning the unit without disturbing it, to yield (4) 2½" squares, (4) 2½" x 4½" rectangles, and (1) 4½" square. **1A**

From the light accent fabric, cut (1) 2½" strip across the width of the fabric. Subcut (4) 2½" squares.

From the dark accent fabric, cut (1) 2½" strip across the width of the fabric. Subcut (8) 2½" squares.

2 sew

Gather the (4) 2½" light accent squares and the 4½" white square. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2½" square. Place marked squares on opposite corners of the 4½" white square, right sides facing. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric ¼" away from the sewn seam line. Press toward the corners. **2A**

Repeat with the remaining 2½" squares and corners. **2B**

Gather (2) 2½" dark accent squares and (1) 2½" x 4½" white rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square. Place a marked square on the left end of the rectangle, right sides facing. Sew on the drawn line and trim the excess fabric ¼" away from the sewn seam. Press toward the corner. **2C 2D**

Place another marked square on the right end of the rectangle, right sides facing. Sew, trim, and press as before. **Make 4** flying geese. **2E 2F**

3 block construction

Arrange the 2½" white squares and the units in 3 rows of 3 as shown. Sew them together in rows. Press the seams of each row in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. **3A 3B**

Block Size: 8½" unfinished, 8" finished
