

At Home with Misty & Craig Pecking Order - Fabric Requirements

Sample Project: Kona Cotton Solids - Lemon, Sky, Harbor, and Prussian by Robert Kaufman Fabrics

Project Size: 65" x 69½"

Block Size: 5" unfinished, 4½" finished

Quilt Top:


- ⅔ yard of medium blue fabric
- ⅓ yard of light blue fabric
- ⅝ yard of yellow fabric
 - includes inner border
- 4 yards of dark blue background fabric
 - includes outer border

Binding:

⅔ yard

Backing:

4⅓ yards - vertical seam or
2⅝ yards of 108" wide



1 cut

From the medium blue fabric, cut across the width of the fabric:

- (4) 2½" strips.
 - Subcut up to (16) 2½" squares from each strip for a **total of 60**.

From the light blue and the yellow fabric, cut across the width of each fabric:

- (3) 2½" strips.
 - Subcut (16) 2½" squares from each strip for a **total of 48** of each color.

From the background fabric, cut across the width of the fabric:

- (20) 5" strips.
 - Subcut up to (8) 5" squares from each strip for a **total of 156**.

2 inner border

Cut (6) 1½" strips across the width of the yellow fabric. Sew the strips together to make a long strip.

Measure, cut, and attach the borders. The strip lengths are approximately 59" for the sides and 56½" for the top and bottom.

3 outer border

Cut (7) 5" strips across the width of the background fabric. Sew the strips together to make a long strip.

Measure, cut, and attach the borders. The strip lengths are approximately 61" for the sides and 65½" for the top and bottom.
